ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. D. Dumelle):

This matter comes before the Board upon an October 2, 1986, petition for variance filed on behalf of Deere & Company. That petition is deficient in that it fails to include a plan for compliance during the term of variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.121(f). While the petition does contain an allegation that site-specific relief will be requested, that does not constitute a sufficient plan.

Unless and amended petition is filed within 45 days of the date of this Order curing the above-noted defects, this matter will be subject to dismissal.
