ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Anderson):

Respondent.

This petition, filed November 17, 1983, fails to contain much of the information required by Section 104.121 of the Board's Procedural Rules. More specifically, the petition fails to precisely identify the regulations from which variance is sought. The little information presented on environmental impact is a conclusion with no data to support it. No allegation has been made concerning the "arbitrary or unreasonable hardship" Amoco might suffer if variance is denied.

If an amended petition curing these deficiencies is not filed within 45 days of the date of this Order, this petition will be subject to dismissal. As any variance granted concerning control of volatile organic compounds is reviewed by USEPA for compliance with federal informational requirements, Amoco would be well advised to contact the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for more explicit guidance in the preparation of its amended petition.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
