ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

On June 20, 1986, the parties jointly moved the Board to reconsider its Order of May 9, 1986 granting variance to Electric subject to conditions, and to dismiss the petition. The motion asserts that variance relief is no longer necessary because Electric has achieved compliance through modifications in the discharge pattern of the wastestream at issue.

The motions are granted. The Board's Opinion and Order of May 9, 1986 are hereby vacated, and the variance petition is dismissed.
