The Board hereby adopts these rules as proposed in the Board's Order of January 22, 1981 and sent to Admnistrative Procedures Act second notice without change pursuant to the Board's Order of May 28, 1981. At its meeting of July 22, 1981, the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR) has stated that it has no objection to the rules. JCAR, did, however, suggest that existing Rule 103(a) be revised to refer to the "Illinois Administrative Procedures Act" as does new Rule 103(e), rather than to the predecessor "Act Concerning Administrative Rules". The Board has agreed to do so.

The Clerk is directed to file these rules with the Secretary of State, to become effective 90 days after their filing. Board will shortly issue its supporting Final Opinion.
