ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.G. Anderson):

This petition filed April 22, 1982 is deficient in a number of respects. This is understandable, in that the petition indicates that it was prepared pursuant to IEPA form APC-167: Instructions For Filing A Variance Petition. This is an outdated form still distributed by the Agency but which does not incorporate many of the informational requirements contained in the Board's Procedural Rule 401.

The Clerk is therefore directed to serve a copy of the Procedural Rules upon Petitioner along with a copy of this Order, and Petitioner is directed to file an amended petition in conformance with Procedural Rule 401. Petitioner's attention is specifically directed to Procedural Rule 401(b), which requires that hearing either a) be specifically requested, or b) be unconditionally waived, and if so waived that the petition be accompanied by an affidavit attesting to the truth of the facts alleged.

If an amended petition curing these deficiencies is not filed within 45 days of the date of this Order, this petition will be subject to dismissal.
