

Pursuant to this statutory directive, the Board reviewed Pollution Control Facility Certifications and Applications for Certification which were referred to the Board by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for decertification under this language. On the basis of this information and the information presented at hearing, the Board finds that the facility which is the subject of this certification falls within subparagraph (c) of paragraph 502a-2 of the Illinois Revenue Act of 1939, as amended.

OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

The Board provided an opportunity for a hearing to present contrary facts on this matter on December 20, 1983 at 9:00 a.m. at the Pollution Control Board Offices. Such hearings were scheduled if the Board received a request for hearing and a short statement of the facts to be presented at hearing no later than 12:00 noon on December 19, 1983. No such hearing was requested in this matter, and the only evidence presented was on behalf of the People and was in support of the revocation. The subject certification will, therefore, be revoked.

This Opinion and Order constitutes the Board's findings of fact and conclusions of law in this matter.

ORDER

Tax Certification No. 21RA-ILL-WPC-72-8 issued to CIPS-GRAND TOWER is hereby revoked.
