
CONCURRING OPINION (by B. Forcade):

While I agree with the decision to deny the motion to strike, I disagree with the Order requiring Concerned Neighbors to "present a written specification" at hearing. That requirement, in effect, places a burden on Concerned Neighbors to file their closing brief at hearing. Moreover, it does so with full knowledge that the Order is unlikely to be received by Concerned Neighbors until the day before hearing. I cannot support the "written specification" portion of today's Order.
