ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Marlin):

This matter comes before the Board upon a March 6, 1984 motion by the City of Tuscola (Tuscola) to stay decision in this site-specific rulemaking proceeding. In support thereof, Tuscola states that a 75% federal grant for proposed sewer treatment plant improvements is now not available. Furthermore, Tuscola and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency have entered into discussions to identify and design an affordable alternative treatment system.

The motion to stay is granted and this proceeding is hereby stayed until August 6, 1984. Tuscola will provide the Board with a written report on the progress of the above discussions on or before that date.
