ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B. F. Currie):

On February 23, 2022, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Minit Mart, LLC may appeal a January 21, 2022, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Minit Mart, LLC's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 3195 East Division Street, Diamond, Will County. The Agency rejected petitioner's corrective action plan.

The Board extends the appeal period until May 31, 2022, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Minit Mart, LLC fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
