RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE RECORD

NOW COMES Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by and through the Attorney General of the State of Illinois, KWAME RAOUL, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116(a), hereby moves for an extension of time until September 9, 2022 in which to file the Agency record for this permit appeal. In support of this request, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

- 1. On March 17, 2022, the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") ordered Illinois EPA to file the entire record of its determination by Monday, April 10, 2022, unless the Board or hearing officer orders otherwise. Order of the Board, page 2 (March 17, 2022).
- 2. On March 31, 2022, the Board hearing officer entered an order extending the date for the Illinois EPA to file the record to June 9, 2022. Order of the Board (March 31, 2022).
- 3. On May 12, 2022, the Board hearing officer entered an order extending the date for the Illinois EPA to file the record to July 11, 2022. Said order also set this matter for a telephonic status to July 7, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. Order of the Board (May 12, 2022).
- 4. The parties are continuing their negotiations attempting to resolve their disputed issues. Thus, it would not be prudent to file the entire record on or before July 11, 2022. Instead,

the Illinois EPA requests an extension of time, on or before September 9, 2022, to file the entire

record.

5. Respondent conferred with Petitioner and Petitioner is amenable to this extension

of time for the Illinois EPA to file the record on or before September 9, 2022. Petitioner is also

amenable to submitting an additional 60-day waiver of the statutory decision deadline extending

the deadline to and including January 16, 2023.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated herein, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the

Board or hearing officer enter an order: (i) granting the Illinois EPA's motion; (ii) extending the

deadline for Illinois EPA to file the record until September 9, 2022; and (iii) for such other relief

as the Board or hearing officer deems appropriate.
