MOTION TO HEARING OFFICER TO SUPPLEMENT HEARING REPORT

NOW COMES Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, by KWAME RAOUL, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and moves to supplement the Hearing Officer's October 6, 2022 Hearing Report to correct an omission. In support thereof, Respondent states as follows.

1. Hearing in this Matter was held on September 28, 2022. At hearing Respondent requested that the Hearing Officer take Public Notice of the Complaint and Answer in the case *People v. Aqua Illinois Inc.*, 19 CH 1208 (Will County). Plaintiff's request was made in accordance with Section 101.630 of the Board Procedural Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.630.

The Board can take public notice of evidence where the facts are capable of immediate and accurate demonstration. *Gary Polchow v. Village of Rankin*, PCB 15-157 (March 19, 2015); *see also Morton College v. Town of Cicero*, PCB 98-59 (January 8, 1998) (Board takes notice of Circuit Court Complaint for Declaratory Relief).

2. In our Case an Agreed Interim Order entered in 19 CH 1208 is in the record in this matter (R 000602-R000621), and is referred to in the Permit at issue in this Matter. Respondent

believes that the Complaint and Answer in 19 CH 1208 provide background and further information on issues relevant to the Board's consideration of this case.

- 3. Over Complainant's objection, the Hearing Officer admitted both the Complaint and Answer at hearing as Hearing Officer Exhibit A (transcript of September 28, 2022 hearing, pp. 13-14).
- 4. However, in the October 6, 2022 Hearing Report, the Hearing Officer refers to Hearing Officer Exhibit 1, the "Complaint for injunctive relief", without reference to the Answer.
- 5. Respondent believes that the exclusion of the Answer from the October 6, 2022 Hearing report was inadvertent, as it was already admitted at hearing. Respondent therefore requests that the Hearing Report be supplemented to include the reference to the admitted Answer in 19 CH 1208.
