PCB 2023-55 Response to motion

Respondent filed a motion to have the above case dismissed for being frivolous. The motion contains intentionally false information in an attempt to manipulate the board. And is based around a discriminatory attack on autistic people, a protected class, who think/perceive differently. Citing totally irrelevant uses of language to try and strip my standing as if this was criminal court. Mine went diagnosed until after school creating many issues. I do not appreciate the lack of sensitivity to Autistic people speaking in overly specific terms.

What is Idiosyncratic speech in autism?

A common characteristic of speech in children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), idiosyncratic language is described as **stereotypical and inappropriate word use**. These unusual utterances include pedantic speech, in which the child uses overly specific details.

"Management" meant the only time Pulte staff come near me is to photograph my car so they can call the police and make a false report, a violation of IL Disorderly Conduct Law. I was referring to the person I handed the paperwork to, a manager/superintendent/land developer. Nobody gives me any information and I am not interested in creating power struggles or standing in front of these people any longer than I need.


Respondent claims I left the documents on the ground, but clearly did not do any research or talk to the superintendents because the same person took the form at another location. The second time he said "thanks". The time at Naper Commons he was very rude and antagonistic.

The rest of the motion contains references to laws not applicable to this kind of case in further attempts to manipulate the board. This is not a citizen enacted lawsuit seeking an injunction or other monetary damages. This is a citizen enforcement action subject to a much lower threshold than criminal court and which operates in the spirit of which the law is intended.
