The Attorney General has brought a case against PP Flexible Packaging for violating State pollution contributes. On January 6, 2023, the parties filed a stipulation on proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have revested that the settlement be adopted without holding public hearing.
