JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

FACTS

1. That Respondent, Daniel & Shirley Partridge is the present owner of property located in Manlius Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
  2. That said facility is an open dump site, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and is designated with Site Code No. 0998175009 Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as Four-Star Campground.
  3. That the Respondent has owned said facility since February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2007.
  4. That on March 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Lauren Grumieaux, Brian Gift, and Myranda Posada of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. On the basis of direct observations of Lauren Grumieaux, Brian Gift, and Myranda Posada of the LaSalle County Department of Land Use, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above-described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

#### CIVIL PENALTY

6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred(\$1500.00). Additionally, should Respondents elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.

If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after the adjudicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

## NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

### GENERAL REMARKS

On March 10, 2023, an open dump and open burn inspection was conducted at 2776 E 2625<sup>th</sup> Rd., Marseilles, IL by Ms. Lauren Grumieaux, Ms. Myranda Posada, and Mr. Brian Gift representing the LaSalle County Land Use Department, under the delegation authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Weather conditions on March 10, 2023, were 36°F wind NW at 13mph

The inspection was conducted in response to a complaint alleging open dumping and burning.

Ms. Grumieaux, Mr. Gift, and I arrived at the site at 11:18 AM and met with an employee (Bill Partridge) on site. Mr. Gift introduced himself and explained that we were on site due to complaints alleging open dumping and open burning at the campground. Bill agreed to take us to the area where they have controlled burns on the parcel. A sign reading, the outback, was viewed in the area of the burn pile. After a review of the GIS maps, Ms. Grumieaux stated that the "Outback" was located on the neighboring property. The neighboring property to the north is owned by Michael Beck.

After inspecting the neighboring property, Mr. Gift asked if trailers were still being demolished on site. Mr. Partridge stated that they were still demolishing trailers and currently had an employee on-site, working to break down the discarded batch. Mr. Partridge explained, once the trailer has been deemed abandoned, they move the trailers into the northwest portion of the campground. There, they demolish and scavenge any materials worth saving, to help offset the cost of disposal. Mr. Partridge then led the way to the northwest portion of the property.

Once out of the vehicle, we proceeded on foot to view the area. A gate was documented at the entrance of the drive. Making our way through the gate and down the drive, we came to a clearing in the trees. Partially demolished trailers lined the entranceway. (Photo #1) Mr. Partridge explained that they were not burning the trailers, and planned to haul the waste to the landfill. Facing northeast, I viewed another partly demolished trailer and a boat. The trailer was filled with demolition debris and some household furniture. (Photo#2) Continuing west, we noted a very potent stench (sewage) coming from the area. Mr. Partridge assured us that all trailers are connected to septic tanks.

Looking South, I documented a large pile of waste in the area. The pile contained household furniture, demolition debris, plywood, totes, five-gallon buckets, pieces of wood, pallets, and tires. (Photo #3) The perimeter of the clearing was lined with waste at the time of the inspection. Some of the items viewed included mattresses, tires, demolition debris, household items, fans, plastic storage bins, and a child's sandbox. (Photo #4) I documented approximately 6 trailers in various stages of demolition, in the area.



Next, I viewed the area to the north. Construction and demolition debris had been strewn throughout the area. (Photo#5) A second pile of waste was documented in the area. The second pile contained more electronics, a TV, demolition debris, lawn furniture, household waste, and tires.

Near the center of the clearing, we watched as the employee continued to move metal items from the crushed trailers. As I continued east, I documented one trailer that was fully furnished at the time of the inspection. I noted broken glass littering the ground. A recliner, cardboard boxes, and clothing had all been discarded onto the ground near the broken glass. (Photo #6) More trailers and household items littered the area to the east. (Photo #7) Mr. Gift viewed the eastern perimeter, to gain a better view of the hillside and ravine. Mr. Gift stated that the waste was being contained to the area, and not pushed over the hill. (Photo #8)

Lastly, we viewed an area on the property labeled Outback #2. Outback #2 contained a pile of landscape waste comingled with a deck, construction materials, a barrel, an Ag storage container, a TV, and more miscellaneous waste. (Photo#9 - #11) After documenting our findings, Ms. Grumieaux, Mr. Gift, and I concluded the inspection at 10:53 AM.
