

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On June 20, 2002, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until September 6, 2002, the time period within which Charles Stanford (Stanford) may appeal a May 1, 2002 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000) *as amended by* P.A. 92-0574, eff. June 26, 2002; 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Agency modified Stanford's proposed budget for purposes of reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund. The proposed budget relates to Stanford's high priority corrective action plan regarding a leaking underground storage tank at 815 East North Avenue, Flora, Clay County. Because Stanford failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
