
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 14, 2023, Complainant filed “Complainant’s Responses and Objections...Round 2”. Due to the confusing nature of this filing, and the unclear found objections therein, complainant is directed to file a motion to compel by August 7, 2023. (*See* 735 ILCS 5/2-615). Respondent to file its response by August 21, 2023. The complainant is also directed to be succinct, specific, and reconsider his relevancy arguments. To wit: On April 7, 2022, the Board stated that “[t]he complainant alleges that New Trier violated the Board’s noise regulations[found] at 901.102(a) and (b) (35 Ill. Adm. Code 901.102(a), (b)) by emitting sounds from the dust collector and other equipment at the New Trier Site, which is located near a residential area.” Kruk v. New Trier High School District No. 203, PCB 2010, slip op. at 2 (April 7, 2022).

Respondent reported that it has rescheduled a new round of testing by the Shinner Group that will take place on July 20, 2023, at 9:00 p.m. Respondent anticipates that the testing will include all equipment that complainant has issues with. It is also anticipated that a representative of the New Trier District, its attorney and complainant will be present.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on July 27, 2023, at 10:45 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. The respondent will provide the call-in number.


