This Rulemaking is captioned R24-08 Definition of Volatile Organic Material, 13 USEPA Amendments, January 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023. 15 This hearing is being held to satisfy the public hearing requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act. This is an identical and substance rulemaking under 17 Sections 7.2 and 9.1E of the Illinois Environmental 19 Protection Act. During the update period of this docket, 20 USEPA added a single exclusion from the Federal 21 definition of Volatile Organic Compound. The Board today 22 proposes amendments to Illinois definition that are identical in substance to the USEPA action. 23 24 On October 19, 2023, the Board issued the
