<u>AC 24-4</u>	<u>County of LaSalle v. Joseph & Stephanie Stevens</u> (Land) – After neither Joseph Stevens nor Stephanie Stevens timely filed a petition to contest this administrative citation, the Board found that they had violated Section $21(p)(1)$ and $(p)(3)$ of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS $5/21(p)(1)$, $(p)(3)$ (2022)) as alleged. Because there were two violations of Section $21(p)$, the Board ordered the Stevens to pay a total civil penalty of \$3,000, reflecting the statutory penalty of \$1,500 per violation.	4-0 roll call vote

Rochelle Energy LLC</u> (Air, CAAPP – Enforcement) – In this enforcement action concerning Rochelle Energy's landfill gas-to-energy facility in Ogle County, the Board granted relief from the hearing requirement of Section 31(c)(1) of the Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/31(c)(1) (2022)), accepted a stipulation and proposed settlement, and ordered Rochelle Energy to pay a \$35,000 civil penalty and to cease and desist from further violations.	4-0 roll call vote

IEPA issued a non-concurrence in response to IPGC's alternative source demonstration (ASD) for sulfate and total dissolved solids (TDS). The Board reserved ruling on IPGC's motion for a partial stay.	4-0 roll call vote
