

The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule changes proposed by the Board on September 5, 2021: National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS), USEPA Amendments (January 1, 2024, through June 30, 2024), R25-7. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearing or to submit written comments. The docket R25-7 would update the Illinois ambient air quality requirements to correspond with amendments to the federal National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQSs) that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) adopted during the first half of 2024.
