4	acting hearing officer for this rulemaking.
5	With me is Chair of the Board
6	Barbara Flynn Currie in Chicago, and in
7	Springfield Board Member Michael Mankowski.
8	This rulemaking is captioned R25-7
9	National Ambient Air Quality Standards USEPA
10	Amendments January 1st, 2024, through July 1st,
11	2024.
12	This hearing is being held to satisfy the
13	public hearing requirements of the federal
14	Clean Air Act.
15	This is an identical-in-substance
16	rulemaking under Section 7.2 and 10(h) of the
17	Illinois Environmental Protection Act.
18	Section 10(h) requires that the Board
19	requires the Board to adopt standards that are
20	identical in substance to the National Ambient Air
21	Quality Standards adopted by USEPA under
22	Section 109 of the Clean Air Act.
23	To briefly recap, USEPA actions during
24	the timeframe of January 1st through July 1st of



1	2024, USEPA on March 6th of 2024 revised the
2	standards of Primary Annual Particulate Matter 2.5
3	from 12 to 9 milligram per cubic meter.
4	USEPA set the stronger standards due to
5	human health effects associated with long and
6	short term exposures to Particulate Matter 2.5 in
7	ambient air.
8	Second, on June 12th, 2024, USEPA adopted
9	its list updated its list of designated
10	reference and equivalent methods to include one
11	new method for measuring concentrations of ozone
12	in ambient air.
13	The Board proposes to incorporate the
14	June 12th, 2024, version of the list in its rules.
15	On September 5th, 2024, the Board issued
16	the proposed rule change and proposal for public
17	comment. Notice of this hearing was published in
18	11 newspapers in different geographical locations
19	throughout the state. This began the period of 45
20	days of public comment. The end of this comment
21	period was November 3rd, 2024.
22	The Board has not received any comments
23	to-date.

The Board plans on adopting these

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Τ.	proposed changes at its November 21st Board
2	meeting with a possible filing and effective date
3	of November 21st and a possible Illinois register
4	publication date of December 6th.
5	Notice of the hearing was published in
6	the Chicago Sun-Times, the Belleville

8	State Journal-Register, the Centralia and
9	Mount Vernon Morning Sentinel, Metropolis Planet,
10	the Peoria Journal Star, The News-Gazette, the

13	occurred before September 27, 2024.
