

MINUTES

FORMAL BOARD MEETING, January 6, 1972, Rockford, Illinois

Mr. Kissel was on vacation.

The Board voted 4-0 to adopt the following opinions and orders: ##71-15R, Mt. Carmel (on motion to reduce bond); 71-200, Molex; 71-259, Monmouth; 71-289, Valley Line; 71-304, Forest Preserve; 71-311, Rockford (Mr. Currie first adding a condition requiring a report as to the feasibility of preventing further leaching); 71-318, Alton Box (Mr. Dumelle's motion to raise the penalty to \$1000 failing for want of a second); 71-329, American Generator; 71-331, Chicago-Dubuque; 71-350, Wojcik; 71-390, Andros Corporation. #71-290, Abel was adopted 3-1, Mr. Dumelle dissenting; #71-391, Ravinia Festival, was adopted 3-0, Mr. Lawton taking no part.

Mr. Dumelle made the following motions regarding the Effluent Standards, #R70-8, all of which failed for want of a second: to postpone consideration until January 10; to lower the barium standard to 1.0 mg/l; cadium to 0.01; chromium trivalent to 0.1 and hexavalent to 0.1; lead to 0.05; selenium to 0.01; silver to 0.05; and phenols to 0.2. The regulations and opinion were then adopted 4-0, as were the opinion and regulations in ##R70-17, DuPage Regionalization, and R71-16, Asbestos.

Action on minutes for December 21 was deferred. Mr. Dumelle noted his concurrence in all actions taken at that meeting.

The filing of #72-1, EPA v. C&S Motor Service, was noted. A hearing is mandatory.
