

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

MINUTES OF FORMAL BOARD MEETING

FEBRUARY 3, 1972, 309 W. WASHINGTON STREET, CHICAGO, ILL.

The Board adopted the following opinions and orders by a vote of 5-0; ##71-73, Decker Sawmill; -161, Patricia Devel.; -232, Scott AFB; -277, Mattison Machine; -302, Whetzel; -319, Holland; -325, Airtex; -337, Lake County DPW, Mr. Dumelle agreeing to add a reference to the earlier order, to discuss the 90-day question, to cite the Orland Park case, and to note that the lagoons were nearly built; and 72-32, Niles Terrace, and -33, Flora. Mr. Dumelle moved to postpone decision in #71-236, Solid Waste Disposal Co., pending further study of the financial exhibits; no second was made. The opinion was then adopted 4-1 over Mr. Dumelle's dissent.

Discussion of # 71-303, Burkett, and of the Emission Regulations, #R 71-23, was postponed to Feb. 7, as were motions and new cases.

Mr. Dumelle observed that the AEC charges substantial permit fees for nuclear facilities, as much as \$300,000 for a construction permit and more for an operating one.

Mr. Lawton asked the Board to adopt an order prescribing the form of bond in #71-44, noting that the Agency but not the company had responded to our earlier orders asking for forms to resolve the dispute, and the Board adopted his proposed opinion and order 5-0.
