Minutes of Regular Board Meeting May 30, 1972 - Suite 300, 309 West Washington Street, Chicago

All Board Members were present.

Mr. Currie stated in R71-25, Mine Waste, the Board had approved this action last week. Final copy has been submitted with the necessary corrections.

The following opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0:

City of Arcola v. EPA, PCB 72-18; EPA v. Village of Lake Zurich, PCB 72-26, with the Board imposing a small fine of \$100.

In State Line Foundries, Inc., PCB 71-86, the Board, by a vote of 4-1, denied the Motion for the Reduction of Penalty. Mr. Kissel was authorized to write the Board's opinion. Mr. Dumelle dissented.

On those cases for Discussion the following action was taken:

EPA v. Holland Ice Cream and Custard Company, PCB 71-318, the Board decided to act on this case next week.

EPA v. Hollywood Brands, PCB 71-367, Mr. Currie stated that the Stipulation had been received. Mr. Dumelle was authorized to draft an opinion for the Board.

In City of Mattoon v. EPA, PCB 62-64, Mr. Lawton was authorized to draft an opinion for the Board.

In City of Rockford v. EPA, PCB 72-115, the Board will act on this case next week.

In EPA v. Processing and Books, Inc., PCB 72-148, the Board will ask for a Response from the EPA before any further action is taken.

Mr. George Sullivan appeared before the Board for a discussion of the draft of the Regulations for the Control of Wastes from Livestock Feedlots, Poultry Lots and Other Animal Lots. The Board authorized a hearing date be set in this matter.

PCB 72-220, Pepper Valley Development v. EPA and PCB 72-221, EPA v. Laclede Steel Company, the Board authorized hearings. Mr. Dumelle dissented in PCB 72-220.

A closed session to discuss pending litigation was then held.
