Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
December 20, 1973 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0: ##71-51C, Champaign (on remand); 72-465, Del Monte; 73-37, Nalco; 73-313, Union Carbide; 73-353, Naumann; 73-397 through 73-401, Amoco; 73-338, Winnetka; 73-412, Berkquist; 73-415, Midwest Freight; 73-419, Nashua; 73-428, Galva; 73-438, Crest; 71-352 and 72-10, Packaging.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #73-262, Texaco by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #73-413, Monsanto by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Marder dissented.

An Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 4-1 in #73-387, Continental Can, Mr. Henss dissented.

A proposal in R72-20, Mine permits was dismissed 5-0.

An Order on petition for reconsideration in ##72-185, -327, Spinney Run Farms was adopted 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion for modification in #72-468, Elizabeth St. Foundry was construed as a variance and ordered held for Agency Recommendation.

Motion for stay of shut-down was granted to March 31, 1974 in #73-40, Commonwealth Edison by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

An order on motion for extension of penalty date was adopted 5-0 in #73-74, Reliable Armature. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion for modification was denied by a vote of 5-0 in #73-341, Barrett Varnish, Mr. Marder will prepare an order.

An Order requesting additional information was adopted in #73-463, Putnam County Schools by a vote of 4-0.
