Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
February 28, 1974 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##73-309, Metal Dross; 73-382, Allied Chemical; 73-482, Illinois Power; 73-505, Allen Industries; 73-511, Litho-Strip.

An opinion and order was adopted in #73-558, A. B. Dick by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle did not participate in the discussion or decision of the matter.

Motion for rehearing in #73-357, Ringbauer v. Foremost was denied 5-0. Mr. Seaman will prepare an order.

Motion for default in #73-462, Interlake was denied 5-0. Mr. Henss will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #73-559, International Harvester was denied 5-0. Mr. Marder will prepare an order.

In #74-20, C.B.E v. Circuit Etchings, motions to dismiss, one was dismissed as moot 5-0, Mr. Marder will prepare an order; the other was denied 5-0, Mr. Henss will prepare an order.
