

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
March 28, 1974 LaSalle, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Mr. Marder introduced the Board Members and briefly outlined Board meeting procedure to the public present.

Opinions and orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##71-368, Glidden-Durkee; 72-114, Apex Smelting; 73-384, Central Ill. Public Service Co.; 73-422, -461, Arcola; 73-477, Tuck Ind.; 73-550, Ill. Gulf R. R.; 74-1, Abex Corp.; 74-6, Allied Chemical; 74-45, Holland Ice Cream; 74-88, City of Silvis. An order of non-disclosure will be incorporated into the Opinion in #74-1, Abex.

Public comments were allowed. Inquiries regarding landfill permits, public water supplies and animal wastes were referred to the proper parties at the Environmental Protection Agency.

No action was taken on a motion to dismiss in #72-270, Marblehead Lime. It will be assigned to a Board member for review and possible proposed opinion.

Motions to dismiss in #73-514, National Phosphate were denied by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Odell prepared the order.

In #74-70, A. O. Smith Corp., additional information was requested 5-0 and the motion to dismiss by the Agency was held. Mr. Marder will prepare an order.

Motion to dismiss in #74-77, Hammond Organ was denied 5-0. Dr. Odell prepared the order.

Motion for reconsideration in #73-525, Abex was held for the Agency response.

Motion for extension of time to file response in #74-87, Commonwealth Edison was granted to April 15, 1974 by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an order.
