MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
July 20, 1978 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #75-482, Peabody Coal by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Young abstained.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 5-0 in these cases: ##77-180, Armak (Order only); 77-282, Boente; 77-316, Commonwealth Edison; 78-92, Metropolitan Disposal; 78-103, Ralph Korte; 78-117, Bird and Son; 78-166, Globe Wholesale.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #78-123, Citizens Utilities by a vote of 4-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

A motion to amend in #75-109, Illinois Power was construed as a new case and ordered given a new number. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order asking for more information. The vote was 5-0.

Motion to withdraw in #76-251, Joslyn was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for additional time for accepting variance was denied by a vote of 5-0 in #77-221, CIPS. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #78-50, North Shore Sanitary District staying proceedings pending the filing of an amended complaint by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

Motion for summary judgment in #78-69, Preusen was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

A letter asking for reconsideration in #78-94, E. St. Louis will be responded to by Mr. Dumelle.

Motion to extend time in #78-96, St. Jacob was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to leave to withdraw in #78-120, Farmington was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #78-129, Village of Itasca was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #78-130, Joliet was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #78-132, Village of Millstadt, motion for counterclaim was dismissed and the Hearing Officer was ordered to stay proceedings and set a briefing schedule on a motion to dismiss by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

Third party complaint was dismissed in #78-153, Carlstrom by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time in #78-155, Western Illinois Power was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time in #78-167, Salem was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in R74-7, Toxic Substances by a vote of 5-0. The proceeding was dismissed.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ##77-314, Rockford Blacktop; 78-165, General Telephone.

R78-4, Proposal to amend Air Regulations, Organic Emissions Revisions and R78-5, Proposed amendments to the Asbestos Regulations were authorized for publication and hearings by a vote of 5-0.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on an agenda for consideration on August 3, 1978.
