Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
January 4, 1979, Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Dr. Satchell, who was ill.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 4-0 in these cases:
##78-64, Moushon Construction; 78-252, Village of Camp Point;
78-259, Olin Corporation.

A Proposed Order was adopted for publication and comment in R76-1, Phosphorus Amendments by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Young concurred.

A Proposed Order was adopted for publication and comment in R77-3, Organic Emissions by a vote of 4-0.

A final Order was adopted in the matter of R77-5, Low Carbon Wastes by a vote of 4-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

Motion to extend time was granted and motion to reconsider denied in #75-475, Thompson Oil by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Young abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #76-248, Ashland Chemical was granted in part and denied in part by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to amend in #77-312, Marion was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time in #77-328, Svoboda v. DuPage was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #78-41, Cargill regarding a motion for modification by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Werner will prepare the Order.

The Board was informed that a Motion for continuance listed on the agenda for #78-62, Davenport Packing had been acted on by the Hearing Officer.

In #78-114, Department of Transportation the Board entered an Order authorizing the motion for reconsideration for hearing. Rich Christopher, Board Administrative Assistant will act as Hearing Officer. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

A joint motion for stay in #78-135, Palos Park was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted regarding a motion for clarification in #78-196, Norge by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for a six month continuance in #78-258, K.L. Oil Co. was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #78-268, Northern Petrochemical denying motion for consolidation, motion for oral argument, motion to strike recommendation and motion to strike response to recommendation. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

In #78-285 Commonwealth Edison, motion to extend time for filing recommendation was granted and joint motion for stay was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to respond to a motion to strike in #78-289, Interlake was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for corrected order in #78-290, Morris Coal was granted and motion for extension of time referred to the Hearing Officer by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An amended petition filed in #78-272, Commonwealth Edison was authorized for hearing and request for extension of time to respond granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Young will prepare an Order.

An amended petition filed in #78-288, Village of Woodlawn was ordered held for an Agency Recommendation.

A letter filed in the matter of #78-292, Howell Asphalt was not construed as an objection but a comment. The Board decided no hearing was necessary.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #76-184, Waste Management by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Goodman abstained.

Olin Corp., hearing mandatory; 78-312, Consolidated Coal Co., hearing authorized; 78-313, Citizens Utilities, held for Agency recommendation; 78-314, Mobil Oil, hearing authorized; 79-1, EPA v. Borden, hearing authorized.

A proposed amendment to the Water Pollution Regulations, Rule 702(e) (IV) filed by the Textile Maintenance Institute was authorized for hearing and publication and assigned docket number R79-1.

A proposed amendment to the Air Pollution Regulations, Rules 204(f)(1) filed by Amoco Oil Co. was authorized for hearing and publication and assigned docket number R79-2.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered placed on an agenda for possible consideration on January 18, 1979.
