

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD
MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JANUARY 24, 1980, CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present.

Mr. Dumelle introduced the Board Members and acknowledged the presence of the regional public information coordinators for the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: #78-102, Dougherty; 79-15, Western Utilities; 79-24, DeSoto; 79-76, S & L Sanitation.

An Order was adopted in #79-172, Arthur Light, by a vote of 3-1. Mr. Werner dissented.

Orders were adopted in #79-232, Village of Addison and 79-233, Village of Sycamore by vote of 4-0.

A Proposed Opinion in R76-20 and R77-10, Mine Waste Amendments, was adopted for comment and notice by a vote of 4-0.

Motion to extend a date in #77-327, U.S. Steel, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Joint motion for reconsideration in #78-54, Amoco Oil, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Request for hearing location change in #79-11, Palos Hills, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Request for oral argument in #79-92 et al, Amax Coal was dismissed as moot by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

An Order was entered in #79-175, Hoerner Waldorf which stayed the Order of the Board entered on January 10, 1980 and granted attorney status by a vote of 4-0. The matter will be considered on February 7, 1980. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for leave to seek interlocutory appeal in #79-142, Citizens Utilities, was granted by a vote of 4-0 and appeal was held to February 7, 1980. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for modification in #79-188 et al, Caterpillar Tractor, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw in #79-196, Village of Lisle, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to waive hearing in #79-230, Stauffer Chemical, was granted by a vote of 4-0. No Order will be entered.

Motion for clarification in #79-234, Olin, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #79-266, U.S. Steel, was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to modify prior Board Order and allow a continuance in #78-247, #79-111 and #79-114, Continental Grain, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.
