

ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD

Minutes of Regular Meeting
December 13, 1979 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted by a vote of 4-0 in these cases: ##78-237, Lennon Wall Paper; 79-133, Village of Homewood; 79-165, J. Royden Peabody; 79-202, City of Quincy; 79-206, Interpace; 79-83, Interlake; 79;234, Olin Corp. (Order only); 79-157, Southern Illinois Power Cooperative (Order only).

A vote was called for an Opinion and Order for #79-132, Arlington Heights. The vote was 2-2, Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Werner dissented. A second vote was called for and the Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Dumelle dissented.

A Proposed Order was adopted in R76-20, R77-10, Mine Wastes, by a vote of 4-0.

A final Order was adopted in R78-6, SO₂ Procedural Rules, by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

A Proposed Order was adopted in R78-9, Explosive Wastes, by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented.

Motion to dismiss in #76-189, Hyon, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #79-5, Crossroads, on a request to change discovery and hearing dates by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #79-10, Zajac v. CTA, on a motion for clarification, by a vote of 3-1, Mr. Werner dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to represent was granted in #79-141, Outboard Marine, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for reconsideration was denied in #79-148, Jarvis, by a vote of 3-1. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time in #79-196, Lisle, was ordered taken with the case.

Motion to dismiss was denied in #79-229, Indiana, by a vote of 4-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to appear and motion to stay were granted by a vote of 4-0 in #79-236, Commonwealth Edison. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for stay was granted in #79-252, Texaco, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss and to amend were granted in #79-256, ESL and Waste Management, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in #75-488, Material Services, notifying the parties that the Board was considering the matter. The vote was 4-0, Dr. Satchell will prepare the Order.

A Proposed Amendment to the Water Quality Standards, Rule 902, was adopted for publication and comment by a vote of 4-0. The number assigned to the proposal was R79-13. Dr. Satchell prepared the Order.

An Order was adopted in R71-23, R77-15 et al, SO₂ and Particulate Regulations, giving special notice of economic impact hearings and taking notice of the remand. Mr. Goodman will prepare the Order.

Hearings are mandatory or were authorized for hearing by a vote of 4-0 in these new cases: ##79-253, Roth et al v. Northern Trust et al; 79-254, Cantrell v. Gaines; 79-256, EPA v. ESL and Waste Management; 79-257, Turnberry Utilities; 78-258, EPA v. Continental Grain; 79-262, EPA v. Mike Maney et al; 79-264, H.J. Bergman Builders; 79-266, U.S. Steel; 79-267, EPA v. CILCO.

Mr. Dumelle was authorized to sign a permit submitted by the Illinois Department of Transportation for City of Evanston, PCB 79-255, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

These cases were dismissed as inadequate by a vote of 4-0: ##79-259, Fassero Oil; 79-260, Illinois Community College; 79-265, City of Rolling Meadows. Mr. Goodman will prepare #79-265.

Additional information was requested in #79-261, City of Monmouth, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Minutes of Board meetings held August 23, September 6 and 13 and November 6, 1979 were approved as amended by a vote of 4-0.

Mr. Rich Christopher led a discussion of "SIP" hearing notice requirements.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on January 10, 1980.
