Minutes of Regular Board Meeting  
September 18, 1980 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 78-121, Storey; 80-150, Rossmoor; 79-79, Monmouth, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 80-6, Bailey v. Mill Shoals; 75-12, International Harvester; 79-256, ESL (Interim Order).

Motion to dismiss was granted in #79-18, U.S. Postal Service, by a vote of 4-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for modification was granted in #79-135, Bunge Corp., by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Extension of time was granted and motions for rehearing was denied in #79-262, Maney, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss was denied in #79-266, U.S. Steel, and the matter was stayed by a vote of 5-0. Attorney for Petitioner represented that a waiver of time would be filed. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to decide without hearing was granted in #80-67, Sauget, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to file third amended petition was denied and additional information was requested in #80-108, Woodlane, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for stay was granted in #80-116, Borg-Warner, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
