MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
March 10, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present. Chairman Dumelle introduced Board Member Walter Nega who had recently been appointed to the Board. Mr. Nega abstained from voting at the meeting.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0: ## 82-53, Meyercord; 82-140, Algonquin; R81-30, Trade Secrets, Proposed Opinion; R81-29, Pfizer, Proposed Opinion.

A motion for extension of time to respond to a motion, filed by Petitioner in #78-177, Celotex, was granted and the motion was held to March 24, 1983 for consideration, The vote was 4-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Petitioner's motion to dismiss in #82-143, Waste Management, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw the record and replace in #83-14, Hopkins, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Petitioner's motion to dismiss in #83-6, John Prior, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

These case were discussed and held to March 24 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 80-151, Archer-Daniels-Midland; 78-293, Ralston Purina; 80-71, Continental Grain; 81-102, Claude Burch; 82-141, Waste Management v. Will County Board.

R83-7, Petition to amend the Noise Regulations, filed by General Motors, was authorized for hearing and publication.

R83-8, Amendments to New Source Performance Standards, were adopted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order and Resolution.

Mr. Dumelle announced that Bill Withrow would be giving a presentation on leachate at 1:30 P.M. to the Board and anyone who wished to attend.

Mrs. Anderson noted that JCAR had posed several questions regarding R81-17, Combined Sewer Overflow Rules.

Lee Cunningham, noted that the time for filing codified versions of Chapter 7 and 9 might be extended but that he was checking into it.

Morton Dorothy noted that Chapters 2 and 8 were pending codification.

These regulatory matters will be discussed at the March 24 meeting: R80-16, Galesburg WQS; R81-19, Citizens Utilities; R82-5, -10, Effluent Standards Revisions.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on March 24, 1983.
