MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
September 8, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:

Motion to dismiss in #81-20, Metro-East was granted by a vote of
3-2. Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Meyer dissented. Mr. Dumelle will
prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-114, Caterpillar Tractor was granted by
a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to reconsider in #81-149, Willowbrook, was denied by a vote
of 4-0, Mr. Nega abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #83-10, Frink's, was denied by a vote
of 5-0. Mr. Anderson concurred. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an
Order.

Motion for reconsideration in #83-25, Dept. of the Army was denied
by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #83-108, Wiegmann, was granted by a vote of

Motion to file record instanter was granted and motion to dismiss
