September 23, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these matters by a vote of 5-0: ## 79-231, Altamont; 80-117, Revere Copper & Brass; 83-82, Timberlake Estates; R81-2 and R81-8, Air and Noise Codifications (Final Orders); R81-12, Sauget, E. St. Louis, Proposed Rule, First Notice.

Motion for resumption of hearings in #76-84, Santa Fe, was granted by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Nega concurred and Mr. Anderson and Mr. Meyer dissented, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-29, Caterpillar, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to modify in #81-116, Victory Memorial was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to vacate in R83-9, Mt. Olive, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend time for filing an Agency recommendation was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted on a motion for clarification in #83-38, East Peoria, by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Meyer dissented.

Motion for extension of time to amend was granted in #83-105, Ford, Motor, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw petition in R83-5, General Tire, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Nega will prepare an Order.
