All Board Members were present.

An Order was adopted in #81-151, Dean Foods, on a motion for interlocutory appeal, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for rehearing in #83-44, Olin, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. J.T. Meyer will prepare an Order.

In #83-46, Olin, an Order was adopted on a motion for clarification by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file a recommendation in #83-124, Citizen Utilities was ordered taken with the case.
