All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-53, Illinois Power, by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Forcade abstained.

A Proposed Order, First Notice, was adopted in R80-22 (B), Winnetka SO2, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Forcade and Mr. Marlin abstained.

A Proposed Rule, Second Notice, was adopted in R81-12, Sauget/E. St. Louis, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Forcade and Mr. Marlin abstained.

A Final Order was adopted in #80-38, Bacon's Farm by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for briefing schedule in #81-18, Caterpillar, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to correct Order in #83-25, Department of the Army, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Order.

The Board determined that no action was needed in #83-29, Marathon, motion for continuance.

The Board entered an Order in #83-121, Krohn, noting that the open waiver in the matter would stand. The vote was 6-0, Mr. Marlin abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-9, Continental Grain, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.
