All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-73, Searle, by a vote of 6-1. Mr. Forcade dissented and Mr. Dumelle and Mrs. Anderson concurred.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in \$83-125, GHA, by a vote of 7-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R80-22(B),  $SO_2$  Winnetka, by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Forcade abstained.

A Proposed Opinion and Order, Second Notice was adopted in R81-20, Bubble, Useful Life, by a vote of 7-0.

In #76-84, Santa Fe, motion for reconsideration was denied and a question of law was certified by a vote of 7-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in R83-14, Searle, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.
