MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
December 29, 1983 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-73, Searle, by a vote of 6-1. Mr. Forcade dissented and Mr. Dumelle and Mrs. Anderson concurred.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-125, GHA, by a vote of 7-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R80-22(B), SO₂ Winnetka, by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Forcade abstained.

A Proposed Opinion and Order, Second Notice was adopted in R81-20, Bubble, Useful Life, by a vote of 7-0.

In #76-84, Santa Fe, motion for reconsideration was denied and a question of law was certified by a vote of 7-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in R83-14, Searle, was granted by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

These matters were discussed and held to January 12, 1984 for further discussion or possible decision: ##81-155, Bledsoe,; 82-103-104, Illinois Power; 83-79, Rheem; 83-135 and 83-136, Ottawa and Naplate; R82-3, Alton Site Specific.

In R83-19, Lockport, a Proposed Rule, First Notice Order was adopted by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Anderson abstained.

The amended petition filed in #83-160, Town of Stookey, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation.

Since an objection was filed, the amended petition filed in #83-171, Amoco, was authorized for hearing.

Dept. of Transportation, Chairman authorized to sign by a vote of 6-0, Mr. Marlin abstained, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order; 83-237, Wauconda, hearing authorized; 83-238, Chicago Rotoprint, hearing authorized.

Resolutions and Orders were adopted in R83-40,-41 and, -42, New Source Performance Standards by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Orders.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to January 12, 1984 for possible consideration.
