MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING January 26, 1984 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 7-0: ##82-103,-104, Illinois Power; 83-79 Rheem Manufacturing; 83-84, Central Illinois Power.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in ##83-135,-136, Ottawa and Naplate, by a vote of 6-1. Mr. Dumelle dissented.

An Adopted Rule, Final Order, was adopted in R83-9, Algicide Permits by a vote of 7-0.

In #76-84, Santa Fe, motion for appointment of a Special Attorney General was denied. Request for attorney's fees was denied. The vote was 7-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #82-100, Conoco, motion for Substitution of the Petitioner was granted contingent upon the Agency's transfer of the permit by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #83-132, Carter v. Dunn, motion to dismiss was denied by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In #83-133, Inland Steel, motion for Substitution of Petitioner was granted contingent upon the filing of an amended petition. The vote was 7-0, Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motions to withdraw in these cases were granted by a vote of 7-0: ##83-160, Stookey; 83-171, Amoco. Mr. Dumelle will prepare the Orders.

In #83-167, Watts Trucking, an application to intervene was referred to the Hearing Officer.

In #82-122, Bi-Petro, the Board denied a request to accept an amended clause in the Settlement Agreement and gave parties an additional 30 days to amend. The vote was 7-0, Mr. Nega will prepare an Order.

A Second Amended Petition was requested in #83-172, Sycamore, by a vote of 7-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Since an Objection was filed, a hearing was authorized in #83-174, Department of the Army.

These matters were discussed and held to February 9, 1984 for further discussion or possible decision: ##81-132, Borden; 82-55, Waste Management, remand; 83-103, Centralia; 83-106, American National Bank; 83-120, ITT.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #83-144, Rushville, by a vote of 6-1, Mr. Marlin dissented.

These regulatory matters were discussed: R79-14, Air Quality Standards Amendments; R81-25, Chlorinated Solvents; R82-14, RACT III.

In new case #84-6, Monmouth, additional information was requested by a vote of 6-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In other new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 7-0: ##84-7, Illinois Department of Transportation, held to February 9 for consideration; 84-8, Joliet Army, held for an Agency recommendation; 84-9, Midwest Solvents, additional information was requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 84-10, Orchard Hill, additional information requested, Order by Mrs. Anderson; 84-11, EPA v. Cornbelt FS, Inc., hearing mandatory.

A proposal on Algicide rules filed by Applied Biochemists, was docketed R84-4 and accepted for hearing and publication.

The Board then decided to reschedule the regular meeting set for February 23 to February 22, 1984.

All matters not considered as listed were ordered held for possible consideration on February 9, 1984.
