MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
December 20, 1984 Chicago, Illinois

An Order was adopted in R83-17, Stage II Vapor Recovery Controls at Gasoline Dispensing Stations, by a vote of 5-0.

A final Opinion and Order was adopted in R83-26, Cornell Forge, by a vote of 5-0.
