MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
APRIL 2, 1981 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
76-241, Georgia-Pacific; 78-299, Quincy Foods; 80-202, Village of Bluffs; 80-203, Burlington.

An Opinion and Order was presented by Mr. Werner for #81-5, American Foundry. A motion to strike a sentence in the Opinion was made and passed by a vote of 3-2, Mr. Goodman and Mr. Werner dissented. The matter was reassigned to Mr. Dumelle and a vote taken again. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted in R80-9,-10, Blasting Noise, by a vote of 5-0.

A Proposed Opinion was adopted in R80-19, Hazardous Hospital Wastes, by a vote of 5-0, Mr. Werner concurred.

Motion for rehearing in #79-122, Caseyville, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to stay was granted in #79-164, Outboard Marine by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion to substitute petitioner was granted in #80-95, Illini Beef, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for allocation of costs was granted in #80-153, Hamman, by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #81-4, Knoxville, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Request for additional time in #81-12, Wauconda, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motions to withdraw petition in #79-166, Shell Oil, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In R76-14, Forging Noise, motion to allow more time for public comments was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in R81-13, Procedural Rules Amendments, which ordered the matter published for comment. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.
