Minutes of Regular Board Meeting
April 16, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: #78-186, Hartman; 79-72, Travieso v. Highland Hills; 79-205, Weir Machine; 80-121, Regensteiner; 80-176, Sauget, Mr. Goodman concurred; 80-204, Decatur; 80-229, Arlington Heights; 80-230, Crook Development; 80-234, Central Illinois Utility; 81-1, Crystal Lake; 81-6, Convent Sewage Treatment.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-46, Kaji v. Olson, by a vote of 4-1. Mr. Dumelle dissented.

An Order was entered in #81-10, LaSalle et al. v. Pioneer et al., which stated the proceedings. The vote was 4-1, Dr. Satchell dissented.

Motion to modify in #78-236, Kaney, was construed as a new variance petition and ordered renumbered by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to withdraw as attorney and motion to extend time to file brief were granted by a vote of 5-0 in #79-215, Popp. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to extend stay was granted in #80-116, Borg Warner by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for rehearing was denied in #80-31, Burns v. Western Springs by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to decide without hearing was granted in #81-26, Urbana by a vote of 5-0. No written Order was entered.

Motion to dismiss in #81-27, Cabot was denied by a vote of 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to reassign Hearing Officer in #81-21,-22, Davis et al. v. Sapp, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for expedited consideration was denied and a hearing was authorized pursuant to an objection in #81-40, Olin. The vote was 5-0, Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Motion to dismiss in #81-42, Potomac, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

The Board on its own motion authorized a hearing in #81-44, Granite City Steel.

An emergency motion for stay was considered in ##80-189,-190, Alburn and the Board decided to reconvene again at 4:00 P.M. to consider the motion.
