May 14, 1981 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #75-112, Metropolitan Sanitary District, by a vote of 4-0, Mrs. Anderson abstained.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #78-136, Village of Rockdale, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson, Mr. Goodman and Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Order was adopted in #80-184, Akron Land, by a vote of 5-0. The case was dismissed. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.

Opinions and Order were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 80-227, West Chicago; 81-16, Casey; 81-36, East Peoria; 81-45, Woodstock.

R81-17, Economic Impact of Combined Sewer Overflow was accepted for hearing and publication by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

A Final Order was adopted in #79-276, Monterey Coal, which dismissed the case the vote was 5-0. Dr. Satchell will prepare an Order.
