All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0: ## 77-157, Decatur Sanitary District; 80-4, Alba Manufacturing; 80-177, McLean County Services; 81-4, Knoxville; 81-19, Marion, Mr. Goodman concurred; 81-30, Quincy; 81-57, Freeport; 81-60, Kaney Transportation; 81-87, Sparton Manufacturing; 81-99, Hartford (Order); 81-108, Fairfield.

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #80-225, GTE, by a vote of 3-2, Mr. Goodman and Mr. Werner dissented.

R78-7, Flouride, Proposed Rule, First Notice, was adopted by a vote of 5-0.

Pursuant to a request for order by the Hearing Officer in #79-26, -167, Continental Grain, the Board ordered a discovery schedule be established and a hearing set as soon as possible. The vote was 5-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to respond to a motion for reconsideration in #79-134, Commonwealth Edison, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for rehearing in #81-12, Wauconda, was denied by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #81-104, Illinois Fruit, the record was ordered incorporated into #80-181, Illinois Fruit, but not consolidated. The vote was 5-0, Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.
