MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
JUNE 15, 1995 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning asked the Clerk for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except for J. Yi who was absent.

An Order opening a comment period until July 7, 1995, to allow comments on the effects of a change in the regulation, limiting the comments to the correction as presented in the order, and granting the Agency until July 14, 1995 to file any response to any comments filed on the matter, was adopted in R94-1, Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.202, 302.208, 302.212, 302.213, 302.407, 304.122 and 304.301 (Ammonia Nitrogen, Lead and Mercury), by a vote of 6-0. (ED)



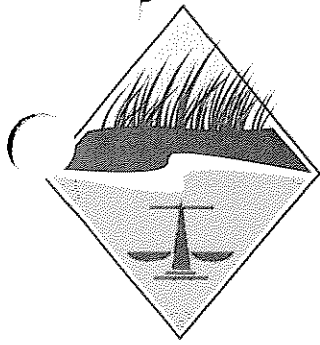

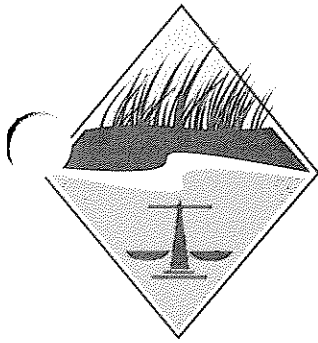
