MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING JUNE 20, 1996 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except for J. Yi who was on vacation.

Minutes of the June 6, 1996 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 6-0.

In R92-8, Proposed Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle C (Water Toxics & Bioaccumulation), an Order denying the Illinois Chapter of the Sierra Club, Citizens For A Better Environment, Lake Michigan Federation and McHenry County Defenders' motion for reconsideration, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. **(RCF)**

In R95-20, RCRA Update, USEPA Regulations (January 1, 1995 through June 30, 1995, July 7, 1995, September 29, 1995, November 13, 1995 and June 6, 1996), an Adopted Rule, Final Order, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. **(ED)**

In R96-1, Proposed Alternative Standards for Coal Combustion Power Generating Facilities Waste Landfills: 35 Ill. Adm. Code Part 816, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice, Opinion and Order, was adopted by a vote of 6-0. **(CAM)**

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #AS 96-8, Petition of Central Illinois Light Company (Duck Creek Station) for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.208 and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 304.105, by a vote of 6-0. **(RCF)**



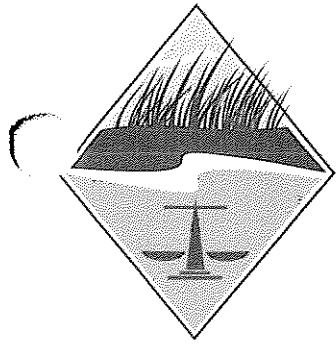

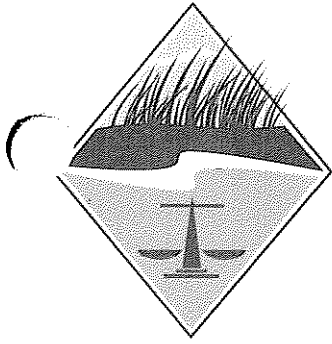
