MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING AUGUST 1, 1996 CHICAGO, ILLINOIS - 10:30 A.M.

After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Manning welcomed members of the public and staff to the meeting. Thereafter, the Clerk was asked for a roll call and all Board Members answered present except Board Members Dr. Ronald C. Flemal and Marili McFawn, who were on vacation.

Minutes of the July 18, 1996 Board Meeting were approved by a vote of 5-0.

In R96-4, Listing of Federal Hazardous Air Pollutants, Great Lakes Commissions Toxic Compounds and Great Waters Program Toxic Compounds, and Source Reporting for Illinois Toxic Air Contaminants: Amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 232, a Proposed Rule, First Notice, Opinion and Order was adopted by a vote of 5-0. **(JY)**

This Adjusted Standard was accepted by the Board and held for the agency's recommendation: #AS 96-10, Petition of Commonwealth Edison Company for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.211(d) and (e).

An Order dismissing the proceedings and directing the Clerk of the Board to close the docket, due to the petitioner's failure to file a certificate of publication on or before July 11, 1996, was adopted in #AS 96-11, Petition of Chemetco, Inc. for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 720.131(a), (c), by a vote of 5-0. **(CAM)**

This Adjusted Standard was accepted by the Board and held for the agency's recommendation: #AS 96-12, Petition of Illinois Department of Transportation, District 8 for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 302.208, 304.124 and 302.203 (if required).

An Opinion and Order was adopted in #94-240, International Union, United Automobile, Aerospace and Agricultural Implement Workers of America and UAW local 974 and Citizens For a Better Environment v. Caterpillar, Inc., IEPA, Party-in-Interest, by a vote of 5-0. **(CAM)**

An Opinion and Order granting the parties' joint motion for waiver of hearing requirement, and accepting the Stipulation and Proposal for Settlement in the amount of \$35,000.00, was adopted in #96-169, People of the State of Illinois v. Kerr-McGee Refining Corporation, by a vote of 5-0. **(GTG)**

A Default Order finding that the respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(3) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, and assessing a \$1,000.00 penalty, was adopted in #AC 96-53, IEPA v. Elmer Meints, by a vote of 5-0. **(CAM)**



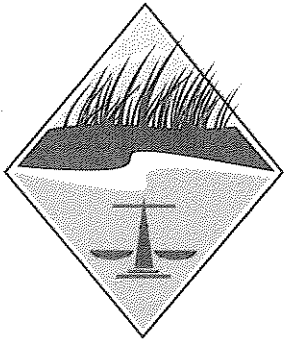

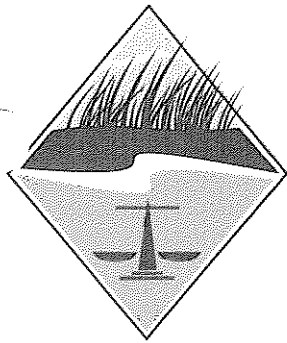
