MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
January 21, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Werner who was ill.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0:

79-235, Reynolds Metals, Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Anderson concurred;
79-249, Monmouth, Mr. Dumelle concurred; 80-107, Monmouth; 81-50,
United Steel Drum, Mr. Anderson concurred; 81-63, Jaraczewski;
81-162, Lena; 81-169, Marion; 81-188, American Fly Ash.

An Order proposing Sulfur Dioxide Amendments, R82-1, was adopted
by a vote of 4-0. Publication and inquiry hearings were authorized.

Motion to withdraw in #77-231 Paxton Landfill, was granted by a
vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

An appeal from the Hearing Officer's ruling on a motion for con-
tinuance was denied in #79-210, Sours Grain and the ruling was
upheld. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Dumelle concurred. Mr. Goodman
will prepare an Order.

Motion to supplement the record in ##80-189,-190, Alburn, was denied
by a vote of 4-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

A request to change the hearing location and time in #81-76, Kraus
v. M.S.D. was denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare
an Order.

Motion to dismiss an amended complaint in #81-98, Wasteland, was
denied by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for modification in #81-129, Peru, was granted by a vote
of 3-0, Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Since an objection was filed, a hearing was authorized in #81-205,
Carol Stream, by a vote of 4-0.
