MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
April 1, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present save Mr. Werner who was ill.

An Opinion and Order was adopted on #75-11, Republic Steel by a vote of 3-0. Mrs. Anderson abstained.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 4-0:  
## 81-127, Northern Anglers v. Kankakee Water; 81-189 and 81-192, National Can; 81-209, Hoffman Estates.

#82-3, American Air Filter was dismissed by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

An Order was adopted in R81-1, Procedural Rules Codification, for public comment by a vote of 4-0.

In R81-17, Combined Sewer, Proposed Rule, First Notice and a Proposed Opinion, were adopted by a vote of 4-0.

R82-5, Proposed Effluent Standards Revisions, were adopted for hearing and comment by a vote of 4-0.

An Order was adopted in #79-235, Reynolds Metals, on a motion for reconsideration. The vote was 4-0, Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time was granted in #80-126, Olin, by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #81-10, LaSalle, motion for stay was denied and a prior Board Order corrected by a vote of 3-0, Mr. Anderson abstained. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion to waive hearing and decide based on the pleadings was granted in #81-107, Abingdon. The Clerk was ordered to cancel the hearing.

Motion to dismiss a count in #81-157, Rome, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time to file an amended petition in #81-163, John Deere, was granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

In #81-188, American Fly Ash, motion for rehearing was granted and the matter was reinstated. The vote was 4-0, Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motions to dismiss in #82-4,-5, Amax Coal, were granted by a vote of 4-0. Mr. Anderson will prepare the Orders.
