MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

April 15, 1982 Chicago, Illinois

All Board Members were present.

Opinions and Orders were adopted in these cases by a vote of 5-0:
79-127, Marquette Heights; 81-205, Carol Stream.

A Final Opinion was adopted in R79-10, Snowmobile Noise Regulations, by a vote of 5-0.

Final adopted rules and a Final Opinion were adopted in R80-11, Ozone and Episode criteria, by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle concurred.

An Interim Order was adopted in #79-35, Chevy Chase, by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Goodman dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Order.

An Order was adopted on a motion to reconsider in #81-190, Chicago, by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare the Order.

Motion to dismiss in #82-12, Aurora, was ordered taken with the case. The vote was 4-1, Mrs. Anderson dissented. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Motion for extension of time in #82-14, Good Hope, was granted by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

Pursuant to a stay order entered in the Appellate Court, the proceedings in #82-15, Hamman were stayed by a vote of 5-0. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

These cases were discussed and held to April 29, 1982 for further discussion or possible decision: ## 78-50, North Shore Sanitary District; 78-226, Modern Plating; 80-125, Welin; 80-224, Beker; 81-161, Quality Ready Mix; 81-176, Conley; 82-10, Orland Park; 82-11, Wenona.

The Board decided to hold a special meeting on April 27, 1982 to consider the matter of an emergency motion for stay in R81-22, RCRA. Mr. Anderson will prepare an Order.

These regulatory proceedings were discussed and held to April 29, 1982 for further discussion or possible decision: R77-12, WQS, Docket D; R80-5, RACT II; R80-6, WQS Amendments; R81-11, Trihalomethanes; R81-18, Waste Disposal Operator Certification; R81-32, U.I.C.; R82-5, Effluent Standards Revisions.

A response to Agency recommendation was construed as a request

for hearing in #82-21, Galesburg. A hearing was authorized by a vote of 5-0. Mr. Dumelle will prepare an Order.

In R81-20, Bubble Rules, a Proposed Rule, Second Notice was adopted by a vote of 5-0.

These amended petitions were held for Agency recommendation: ## 82-23, Trojan; 82-32, Woodridge.

In new cases these actions were taken by a vote of 5-0: ## 82-38, Growmark, hearing authorized; 82-40, EPA v. Radar, hearing mandatory; 82-41, Algonquin, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-42, Village of Glasford, additional information requested, Order by Mr. Goodman; 82-43, Greater Peoria Sanitary District, provisional variance granted, Order by Mr. Dumelle; 82-44, Hanover Park, provisional variance granted, Order by Mr. Dumelle.


The amended complaint was accepted and a hearing was authorized in #82-16, Steel et al. v. Beucher et al., by a vote of 3-2. Mr. Dumelle and Mr. Goodman dissented. Mrs. Anderson will prepare an Order.

#82-39, SCA, was ordered held for an Agency recommendation and the request for a provisional variance was noted as improper. The vote was 4-1, Mr. Anderson dissented. Mr. Goodman will prepare an Order.

Minutes of the regular Board meeting April 1, 1982 were approved by a vote of 5-0.

All matters not disposed of as listed were ordered held to April 29, 1982 for possible consideration.
